Reminders For Snow Birds:

- *Turn off the main water valve. The water valve is located above the water heater in the utility room.
- *Shut the hot water heater off from the circuit breaker panel. In most apartments, it is the #4 and #6 breaker
- *Close and lock all of your shutters. Please leave the key for the shutters and your vehicle on the dining room table.
