Standardized HO6 Insurance Mitigation Forms Available- Our insurance agent, Troy Sumner, has offered to provide Shore Club residents with the new, required universal form for HO6 insurance policies' mitigation credits at a modest rate of \$50 (fees normally range from \$100 to \$150). A copy of the form can be obtained in the Shore Club office.

Sign Up For ACH! And your quarterly maintenance will automatically be debited from your bank account (savings or checking). Fees will be debited around the 5th of the month each quarter, eliminating the chance of incurring late fees. Sign up forms can be picked up in the south office. **The setup deadline for July's maintenance is June 15th, 2010** (set up time is 10 full business days).
