**Thursday August 5** - Cars in parking spaces **121-151** and **243-268** your car needs to be moved to the upper deck by 8:00 AM Wednesday until 6:00 PM Wednesday evening.

If your car is not moved, you will be responsible for the cleaning of your parking space, and the Shore Club will not be held responsible for any damages done to your vehicle.
